

Kharif Farmers' Day in Tansa Farm

For the current *kharif* weather season, a farmers' day was organized on Monday the 3rd October, 2022 at the Tansa Farm, on a central theme entitled, "Introduction of high yielding rice varieties and improved techniques". This is a part of the Foundation's extension programme through which the modern agricultural technologies reaches to the small farmers staying surrounding the Tansa Farm. Dr. Bharat Waghmode, Rice Specialist, Regional Rice Research Station, Karjat, was invited as Speaker on the topic. Dr. Swapnil Dekhane, Agricultural Officer, ARDF, welcomed the guests and gave introductory remarks about the invitees.
